





Graduate Tracking Timeline



Diploma Day

1 month after graduation

Graduates can pick up their diplomas before they are mailed. Graduates are encouraged to take the Graduate Survey at Diploma Day.



E-mail Contact

6 months after graduation

Graduates who did not attend Diploma Day or indicated that they were seeking employment are e-mailed the Graduate Survey link. Three rounds of e-mails are sent out over two weeks.

Phone Contact

6 months after graduation

Graduates that have not responded to the e-mailed survey are contacted via all available phone numbers. The Graduate Survey is administered over the phone.



Colleague Search

6 months after graduation

Graduates that have not responded via e-mail or phone are referenced in Colleague to see if they are still a student at San Juan College.



Online Sources

6 months after graduation

Graduates that have not responded to e-mails, phone calls or are not current students are searched through online sources including The New Mexico Department of Labor, LinkedIn and Facebook to gather employment or transfer information.


Report is Created

It was great, really friendly and helpful here.



Had the best college experience here. Going to continue my education here.







I earned an AAS Information Technology and went on to earn a Business Management Certificate. Currently working on my Cyber Security Certificate. I really enjoy having a college in this small town.



I believe the education was fine, but I also think the general educational system is not beneficial for all learning types. I did well in my program, but did not graduate with training that suited me for continuing on in the field.


After being out of school for over 20 years and returning when COVID hit, it was quite an experience. It was completely different as I have never had to attend classes via Zoom sessions.

I had amazing instructors and finally felt like I had the tools and information available to me to succeed.


